

KINGSWOOD RESIDENTIAL TRIP APRIL 1st-3rd 2019

PACKING LIST:

On arrival, we will be joining with another Catholic School (Ysgol Mair, Rhyl) to walk up Moel Famau in Mold. Children will therefore need to be wearing suitable clothing and footwear.

Please use a small suitcase or large bag

- A packed lunch for the first day (Wednesday)- in a plastic bag
- One bath towel
- Toiletries bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, wet wipes, shower gel or soap, hairbrush etc (no aerosols allowed; only roll on deodorant)
- Pyjamas
- Socks and underwear (also spare socks for evening if day ones get wet)
- Five t-shirts (at least three tops with long-sleeves as many activities require this)
- One thick sweater/hoody plus one light sweater/hoody
- Four pairs of trousers (jeans, tracksuit bottoms, leggings etc)
- Clothes/shoes for evening activities (casual)
- Warm Coat
- Waterproof jacket and trousers
- Three pairs of pumps or trainers (one old pair for activities) (one preferably wellingtons or walking boots). We are doing water activities so one pair may get wet.
- Slippers or sandals (for indoor use)
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Gloves, hat, scarf
- Water bottle (with name on it)
- Medical supplies needed (e.g. asthma inhalers, epi-pen)
- There is an on-site shop if children want to buy souvenirs or snacks (£10 maximum)

Optional: one bag of sweets/snacks, reading book or magazine, playing cards, small board games.

There is <u>no</u> mobile phone coverage in Kingswood. We will use the landline phone to communicate with the school who will update you on our safe arrival etc via the School Spider App and Facebook.

Should you wish, we will allow your child to take their <u>mobile phone</u> to have access for one hour per night in their rooms only. In order to ensure the children get the most from the trip and have the best experience, any phones will be kept safely in the care of Miss Ford at all other times (in a locked bag and room)

Do not bring: expensive cameras/jewellery/clothing/shoes, electronic games. Kingswood can't accept liability for the loss, theft or damage of any personal property your child may bring.
