Where are we now?

160 pupils

7 Classes

8 Full Time Teachers

- 7.5 Learning Support Assistants
- We are the only school in North Wales to be nominated for the national Digital Leaders Award for their work with a local community group.
- We are the only school on Anglesey working towards becoming an ASD Aware School.
- All staff have undertaken advanced Welsh courses to further develop their own skillset which will benefit the children.
- We are currently working with creative practitioners in a highly innovative project as part of the Lead Creative Schools programme.
- We are working with Surfers against sewage and Keep Wales Tidy and help drive the Isle of Anglesey commitment become a Plastic Free School.
- We have continued to develop the special relationship between the school and the church and parish community.

•Four purposes of the curriculum.


- •Six areas of learning and experience.

The National Curriculum

The most significant change is that the children will develop on individual learning continuums with "*Progression steps at ages 5, 8, 11, 14 and 16*".

The Budget

Important Factors

Pupil Numbers

- Admission number of 24
- Two consecutive small nursery intakes
- Reception 10 pupils
- Nursery 13 pupils
- Same in many schools
- 27 applications for September 2019

Budget

- Ed Dept £4million efficiency savings
- £1.4million shortfall 2019-20
- £970k withheld from schools

Combined effect

- £90k deficit in the school budget
- Additional 4.75% Council tax rise reduces that to £69k





Important Factors



Pupil Numbers

• Impossible to retain the current structure of 7 classes

Budget

- 85% of the budget goes on staffing
- £69k deficit equates to 2 teaching posts
- Redundancy process (December 2018)
- Miss Doutch voluntary redundancy
- Ms Somers Temporary Contract
- Changes from September 2019
